NTHC Eitz Chaim Policies

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General

1. A student may join the Eitz Chaim class of the North Tahoe Hebrew Congregation Religious School by meeting the following requirements:
 - (a) The student must have completed the Bar or Bat Mitzvah Process.
 - (b) Parent(s) or student must be members in good standing of NTHC.
2. **In order to register a student, tuition must be paid in full by September 14:** The tuition is \$36.
3. **School will meet monthly on Tuesday from 4:00 - 6:15 pm.** School ends in May 2011. See calendar for exact dates.
4. Students must maintain an 80% attendance record. If classes are missed, the student may make up the sessions by satisfactory completion of work.
5. Synagogue attendance is encouraged. **Family Services are the third Friday of the month. Students must attend at least one Shabbat per Month, ideally the family Shabbat service.**
6. Homework may be assigned. Homework is expected to be returned to class completed.
7. The Rabbi will prepare a progress report at the end of the year and earlier if issues arise. The purpose of the progress report is to evaluate the student's mastery of curriculum, class participation, completion of homework assignments, and attendance.
8. Parents or student can request a private conference with the teacher, the Rabbi or member of the Education Committee at any time.
9. The Education Committee, teachers, staff, and students shall maintain high ethical, religious, and academic standards.
10. There is a no refund policy once registration is submitted and paid.
11. For students joining mid-year, full tuition is required at time of enrollment.

NTHC Religious School Medical Policy

In the case of a medical emergency while a student is at Religious School, the following protocol will be followed:

- 911 will be called if deemed necessary by the teacher
- Parents will be notified immediately of any illness or accident
- In the case of a child becoming ill while at Religious School, the child will be isolated from other students and the parents will be requested to pick up the child immediately. If the parent is not available, the “emergency contact” will be notified for immediate pick up.
- All accidents will be documented by the teacher and the parents will be notified of such accident.

When a student or teacher should not attend Religious School: for everyone’s benefit...

- If a student or teacher is not feeling well, please stay home.
- If a student does not attend secular school for the day, due to an illness or accident, please do not attend Religious School on the same day
- Fever needs to be at a normal (98.6 degrees) for a minimum of 24 hours without the use of fever lowering medication before returning to Religious School
- If medication is being administered, please notify the teacher before leaving the Temple building. No teacher is allowed to administer any medication, prescription or over the counter, to any student at any time.
- Use common sense, please. If you have a runny nose, cough, stomach issues, please stay home. The last thing we want is to have 20 children, under the age of 13 all coming down with a preventable illness.
